# **Gymnastics Equipment**

## Leotards

### **HOW TO CARE FOR YOUR LEOTARDS**

A question I often hear in the gym is what is the best way to wash leotards?

This advice is from Quatro Leotards however please refer to the washing labels on all your leotards as different companies and different materials require different care. I hope this helps!

- > Wash inside out immediately after wearing.
- Machine wash by itself using a gentle cycle with a large volume of coldwater (Quatro say you can use a mild liquid detergent if in doubt leave it out). Some websites suggest using half a cup of table salt instead.
- Remove from the washing machine immediately after the spin cycle and dry on a thick coat hanger.

NO HAND WASHING. NO BLEACH OR FABRIC SOFTNER. NO IRONING. DO NOT DRY FLAT. DO NOT TUMBLE DRY



## **Hand guards**

Only buy equipment eg hand guards, palm guards if your coach advises you to. We recommend Gymnastics Express.

Prior to buying your guards you can read their guide: "The 10 Most Important Things You Must Know Before Buying Gym Grips" **and** request a Finger and Hand sizer that they will send you for free. Your coach can help with the sizing once you have the guide.

# A Guide to Competitions

As of 2017 competitions will take place at Cannock Chase Sports Centre (unless otherwise advised)

- **↓** Competitions are on a Saturday or Sunday dependent on the competition.
- Competition fee is due prior to the competition you will receive a payment request.
- 4 Arrive at the competition in plenty of time. If you are late you can't compete.
- ♣ Bring all necessary equipment music, hand guards, wristbands, loops etc and a drink (water).
- Wear the correct **squad leotard** and have **hair tied back neatly and securely**. Points are deducted for: playing with hair, adjusting your leotard and visible underwear.
- An Entrance fee must be paid by all spectators your hand may be ink-stamped so you can leave and re-enter the gym.
- To take photos/videos you must pay a fee (normally £1) and write your details on a form. You will need to wear a sticker to show you have paid.
- ♣ Optional: There is often a prize draw. Tickets are normally £1 per strip.
- ♣ Optional: DE Photos (www.dephoto.biz) are at most competitions taking action shots. These are displayed in the foyer for you to choose and purchase. You can select 1 to 4 shots for an A4 picture. They can be purchased with or without a frame. There is a nominal charge for paying with a bank card. Cost is £30-£50 and is cheaper onsite than purchasing later from the website.

**Please note:** Coaches are not allowed to communicate with anyone in the audience either verbally, by text or by sign at any time during the competition.

## **DEAR PARENTS:**
